3 FOR the purpose of adding the State as a governmental body eligible to receive

- 4 certain forfeited property; <u>clarifying the jurisdiction to which a court must order</u>
- 5 <u>forfeiture; allowing the Secretary of the State Police to dispose of certain</u>
- 6 forfeited property in a certain manner; providing for the deposit of certain cash
- 7 <u>or money in the State general fund;</u> and generally relating to the forfeiture of
- 8 vehicles, vessels, or aircraft.

# 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

18 In addition to any other fines or penalties provided for a violation of the

19 provisions of this subtitle, any motor vehicle or other vehicle, vessel, or aircraft used

20 or employed in the concealment, conveying or transporting of any explosives during

21 the course of any violation of this subtitle by any person or persons on whom a penalty

22 and/or fine is imposed under the provisions of § 34A or § 34B OF THIS SUBTITLE, shall

23 upon the conviction or convictions be declared by the court to be forfeited to the

1 [county or to Baltimore City,] STATE, TO THE COUNTY, OR TO BALTIMORE CITY as the

2 case may be BASED ON WHICH JURISDICTION INITIATED THE INVESTIGATION;

- 3 provided that no vehicle shall be forfeited hereunder unless the owner thereof
- 4 authorized or permitted such use or employment, and provided further that the
- 5 interest thereby transferred to the [county or Baltimore City] STATE, COUNTY, OR

6 BALTIMORE CITY shall be subordinate to the interest of the holder of any perfected

7 security interest in such vehicle, vessel, or aircraft. The SECRETARY OF THE

8 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, county commissioners or the Mayor and City

9 Council of Baltimore City at their discretion, and after discharging any perfected

10 security interest in such vehicle, vessel, or aircraft, may use the same for public

11 purposes or may exchange, sell or convey it to another person or persons; and any

12 cash or moneys received therefor shall be added to the general funds of the [county or

13 Baltimore City] STATE, COUNTY, OR BALTIMORE CITY.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 15 effect October 1, 1999.
