Crimes - Possession of Child Pornography - Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of changing the crime of possession of child pornography from a
- 4 misdemeanor to a felony; altering the penalty for possessing child pornography;
- 5 and generally relating to possession of child pornography.
- 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 14 419B.
- 15 (a) A person may not knowingly possess any film, videotape, photograph, or
- 16 other visual representation depicting an individual under the age of 16 years engaged
- 17 as a subject of sadomasochistic abuse or in sexual conduct, or in a state of sexual
- 18 excitement, as those terms are defined under § 416A of this article.
- 19 (b) Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a parent from
- 20 possessing visual representations of the parent's own child in the nude unless the
- 21 visual representations depict the child engaged as a subject of sadomasochistic abuse
- 22 or in sexual conduct and in a state of sexual excitement.
- 23 (c) (1) For a first offense a person who violates this section is guilty of a
- 24 [misdemeanor] FELONY and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$2,500]
- 25 \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding [1 year] 2 YEARS or both.
- 26 (2) For a second or subsequent offense a person who violates this section
- 27 is guilty of a [misdemeanor] FELONY and on conviction is subject to a fine not
- 28 exceeding [\$5,000] \$10,000 or imprisonment not exceeding [2] 5 years or both.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
