A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Drivers' Licenses - Refusal to License**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to refuse to license for
4 a certain period of time an individual who has been convicted of certain crimes;
5 and generally relating to the power of the Administration to refuse to license
6 individuals.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 16-201.1.

16 THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REFUSE TO LICENSE FOR NOT LESS THAN 2
17 YEARS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED UNDER § 388 ("MANSLAUGHTER
18 BY AUTOMOBILE, VESSEL, ETC.") OR § 388A ("HOMICIDE BY MOTOR VEHICLE OR
19 VESSEL WHILE INTOXICATED") OF ARTICLE 27 OF THE CODE. IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS
20 IMPRISONED BASED ON A CONVICTION OF § 388 OR § 388A OF THE CODE, THE 2-YEAR
21 REFUSAL PERIOD SHALL BEGIN ONLY AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL HAS COMPLETED
22 SERVING THE SENTENCE.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 October 1, 1999.
