Maryland Vehicle Law - Definition of Highway - Calvert County *Enforcement on Private Roadways*

4 FOR the purpose of modifying the definition of "highway" for purposes of the

5 Maryland Vehicle Law to include in Calvert County certain private roadways

6 within residential subdivisions or communities, regardless of whether the

7 roadway is available for use by the public *authorizing certain police officers to*

8 *enforce the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law on private roadways in*

9 <u>Calvert County that are located within a residential subdivision or community</u>

10 and used for vehicular travel by residents of the subdivision or community; and

11 generally relating to enforcement of the Maryland Vehicle Law in Calvert County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 6

7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

10 (A)["Highway"] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, "HIGHWAY"

11 means the entire width between the boundary lines of any way or thoroughfare of

12 which any part is used by the public for vehicular travel, whether or not the way or

13 thoroughfare has been dedicated to the public and accepted by any proper authority.

14 (B) IN CALVERT COUNTY, "HIGHWAY" INCLUDES A PRIVATE ROADWAY

15 LOCATED WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY FOR VEHICULAR

16 TRAVEL BY RESIDENTS OF THE SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY, WHETHER OR NOT

17 THE ROADWAY IS AVAILABLE FOR USE BY THE PUBLIC.

19 (b) (1)A person may not drive a motor vehicle in violation of any provision of

20 this title on any private property that is used by the public in general, or, in Calvert

County, on any private road located within a residential subdivision or community. 21

23 "Police officer" means an officer authorized to direct or regulate traffic or to make

24 arrests for violations of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law or of local or 25 other traffic laws or regulations.

26 11-205.

27 <u>(a)</u> *Except as otherwise specifically provided in the Maryland Vehicle Law:*

28 The provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law do not in any way add to (1)

29 or detract from the right of any person who is injured or whose property is damaged by

30 the negligent operation of a motor vehicle to sue and recover damages as in the case of

31 the negligent use or operation of any other vehicle; and

32 (2)The violation of any provision of the Maryland Vehicle Law does not

33 give any right of action to any person who would not be entitled to it in the absence of

34 the provision.

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1(b)The provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law do not prevent the owner of any2real property that is used, with permission of the owner and not as a matter of right, by

3 the public for vehicular travel from:

4 <u>(1)</u> <u>Prohibiting the use;</u>

5 (2) <u>Requiring the use to be subject to conditions other than those specified</u> 6 <u>in the Maryland Vehicle Law; or</u>

7 (3) Otherwise regulating the use in his discretion.

8(C)IN CALVERT COUNTY, A POLICE OFFICER MAY ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS9OF THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW ON A PRIVATE ROADWAY IN CALVERT COUNTY10THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY AND USED11FOR VEHICULAR TRAVEL BY RESIDENTS OF THE SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 1999.

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
