- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

- 3 (A) ["Highway"] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, "HIGHWAY"
- 4 means the entire width between the boundary lines of any way or thoroughfare of
- 5 which any part is used by the public for vehicular travel, whether or not the way or
- 6 thoroughfare has been dedicated to the public and accepted by any proper authority.
- 7 (B) IN CALVERT COUNTY, "HIGHWAY" INCLUDES A PRIVATE ROADWAY
- 8 LOCATED WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY FOR VEHICULAR
- 9 TRAVEL BY RESIDENTS OF THE SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY, WHETHER OR NOT
- 10 THE ROADWAY IS AVAILABLE FOR USE BY THE PUBLIC.

- 12 (b) (1) A person may not drive a motor vehicle in violation of any provision of
- 13 this title on any private property that is used by the public in general, or, in Calvert
- 14 County, on any private road located within a residential subdivision or community.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 1999.
