1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education - Educational Excellence Award Program**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing a certain percentage of funds appropriated for the
4 Educational Excellence Award Program to be carried forward to the subsequent
5 fiscal year for awarding; and generally relating to the Educational Excellence
6 Award Program.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 18-309.

16 (A) For any fiscal year, if the funds appropriated for the Educational
17 Excellence Award Program are insufficient to satisfy fully all awards as calculated
18 under § 18-304 of this subtitle, the amount paid to each recipient of an Educational
19 Excellence Award shall be a percentage of that award, as determined in accordance
20 with regulations adopted by the Commission that establish a schedule of reductions
21 for this purpose.

1 (B) EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD GRANTS CALCULATED UNDER §
2 18-304 OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT ARE NOT USED BY THE RECIPIENTS SHALL BE
3 RETAINED BY THE COMMISSION FOR USE IN THE EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE
4 AWARD PROGRAM FOR THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR. THE RETAINED FUNDS SHALL NOT
5 EXCEED 5% OF THE TOTAL FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR THE AWARD PROGRAM IN THE
6 FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH THE UNEXPENDED GRANTS WERE APPROPRIATED.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
8 effect October 1, 1999.
