A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Morgan State University - Procurement Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the procurement authority of Morgan State University
4 to include certain supplies funded by proceeds from State general obligation
5 bonds.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

19 12-107.

20 (b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as
21 follows:

22 (5) the University System of Maryland, without the approval of any of
23 the other primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:

24 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
25 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies,
26 but excluding insurance;

1 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
2 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding
3 banking and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item
4 (1) of this subsection;

5 (iii) construction and construction related services for the
6 University, regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants
7 authority over specific projects or classes of projects; and

8 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments
9 are not paid from the General Fund of the State;

10 (8) Morgan State University, without the approval of any of the other
11 primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:

12 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
13 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies,
14 but excluding[:

15 1. supplies funded by the proceeds from State general
16 obligation bonds; and

17 2.] insurance;

18 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
19 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding
20 banking and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item
21 (1) of this subsection;

22 (iii) construction and construction related services for the
23 University, regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants
24 authority over specific projects or classes of projects; and

25 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments
26 are not paid from the General Fund of the State.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
28 effect July 1, 1999.
