16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

2 12-107.

3 (b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as
4 follows:5 (5) the University System of Maryland, without the approval of any of
6 the other primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:7 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
8 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies,
9 but excluding insurance;10 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
11 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding
12 banking and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item
13 (1) of this subsection;14 (iii) construction and construction related services for the
15 University, regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants
16 authority over specific projects or classes of projects; and17 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments
18 are not paid from the General Fund of the State;19 (8) Morgan State University, without the approval of any of the other
20 primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:21 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
22 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies,
23 but excluding[:24 1. supplies funded by the proceeds from State general
25 obligation bonds; and

26 2.] insurance;

27 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
28 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding
29 banking and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item
30 (1) of this subsection;31 (iii) construction and construction related services for the
32 University, regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants
33 authority over specific projects or classes of projects; and34 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments
35 are not paid from the General Fund of the State.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect July 1, 1999.
