The amount of any grant made by the Department for a flood 16 17 control and watershed management capital project which involves only [State and 18 local government] NONFEDERAL funds and meets the criteria of this subtitle shall be 19 matched by a minimum amount of 25% of PROJECT COSTS IN local GOVERNMENT OR 20 PRIVATE funds. For a flood control and watershed management capital project 21 (ii) 22 which involves federal funding and meets the criteria of this subtitle: 23 The Department may provide up to 50% of the nonfederal 24 share of the PROJECT funding; and 25 2. [The amount of any grant made by the Department shall 26 be matched by a minimum amount of 50% of local funds] LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR 27 PRIVATE FUNDS SHALL PROVIDE NOT LESS THAN 50% OF THE NONFEDERAL SHARE 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 1999.
