- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article State Personnel and Pensions

- 19 (a) This section applies to employees of the Maryland Environmental Service 20 AND NORTHEAST MARYLAND WASTE DISPOSAL AUTHORITY.
- 21 (b) Subject to the regulations adopted under § 2-503 of this subtitle, an
- 22 employee or, while receiving an allowance under the Employees' Retirement System
- 23 of the State of Maryland or the Employees' Pension System of the State of Maryland,
- 24 an employee's surviving spouse:
- 25 (1) may enroll and participate in the health insurance or other benefit
- 26 options established under the Program; and

- 1 (2) except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, is subject to the 2 same terms and conditions as those provided under § 2-507 of this subtitle.
- 3 (c) While receiving an allowance under the Employees' Retirement System of
- 4 the State of Maryland or the Employees' Pension System of the State of Maryland, a
- 5 former employee or a former employee's surviving spouse or dependent child:
- 6 (1) may enroll and participate in the health insurance benefit options 7 established under the Program; and
- 8 (2) except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, is subject to the
- 9 same terms and conditions as those provided under § 2-508 of this subtitle, with the
- 10 employee's service with the Maryland Environmental Service AND NORTHEAST
- 11 MARYLAND WASTE DISPOSAL AUTHORITY being included as part of the employee's
- 12 State service.
- 13 (d) For each participant under this section, the Maryland Environmental
- 14 Service, AND THE NORTHEAST MARYLAND WASTE DISPOSAL AUTHORITY OR ANY
- 15 SUCCESSOR AGENCY, shall pay to the State [an] THE RESPECTIVE employer share of
- 16 the cost of the Program based on the State subsidy allowed under this subtitle.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
