- 16 (A) In St. Mary's County a person 18 years of age or older may serve alcoholic
- 17 beverages in restaurants in connection with serving of a meal. Persons under 21 years
- 18 of age may not act as bartender or barmaid or in any solely bar-related capacity in St.
- 19 Mary's County.
- 20 (B) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE BOARD OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY MAY
- 21 REGULATE THE PLAYING TIME AND NOISE LEVEL OF A MECHANICAL MUSIC BOX,
- 22 LIVE MUSIC, OR A SOUND MAKING DEVICE ON LICENSED PREMISES IF THE SOUND
- 23 DISTURBS THE PEACE, TRANQUILITY, SAFETY, AND HEALTH OF THE SURROUNDING
