1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverage Board - Noise Regulation**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Alcoholic Beverage Board of St. Mary's County to
4 regulate under certain circumstances the noise level and playing time of certain
5 music and sound devices on licensed premises; and generally relating to the
6 Alcoholic Beverage Board of St. Mary's County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 12-219.

16 (A) In St. Mary's County a person 18 years of age or older may serve alcoholic
17 beverages in restaurants in connection with serving of a meal. Persons under 21 years
18 of age may not act as bartender or barmaid or in any solely bar-related capacity in St.
19 Mary's County.

20 (B) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE BOARD OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY MAY
21 REGULATE THE PLAYING TIME AND NOISE LEVEL OF A MECHANICAL MUSIC BOX,
22 LIVE MUSIC, OR A SOUND MAKING DEVICE ON LICENSED PREMISES IF THE SOUND

1 DISTURBS THE PEACE, TRANQUILITY, SAFETY, AND HEALTH OF THE SURROUNDING
2 NEIGHBORHOOD.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 1999.
