12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (A) In St. Mary's County a person 18 years of age or older may serve alcoholic 17 beverages in restaurants in connection with serving of a meal. Persons under 21 years 18 of age may not act as bartender or barmaid or in any solely bar-related capacity in St. 19 Mary's County.
20 (B) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE BOARD OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY MAY 21 REGULATE THE PLAYING TIME AND NOISE LEVEL OF A MECHANICAL MUSIC BOX,
