12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 11-110.

16 (a) (1) In this section "pet" means a domesticated animal.

17 (2) "Pet" does not include livestock.

18 (b) The measure of damages for tortious injuries to OR DEATH OF a pet is the
19 market value of the pet before the injury OR DEATH or the reasonable cost of
20 veterinary care, but not more than [\$2,500] \$5,000 if such charge is greater.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
2 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
3 on or application to any cause of action that arises before the effective date of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 1999.
