12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 16 (a) (1) In this section "pet" means a domesticated animal.
- 17 (2) "Pet" does not include livestock.
- 18 (b) The measure of damages for tortious injuries to OR DEATH OF a pet is the
- 19 market value of the pet before the injury OR DEATH or the reasonable cost of
- 20 veterinary care, but not more than [\$2,500] \$5,000 if such charge is greater.
