1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board for Professional Land Surveyors - License Renewals -**
3 **Continuing Competency Demonstration**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors to
5 adopt regulations to require a demonstration of continuing professional
6 competency for a licensed land surveyor or a licensed property line surveyor to
7 renew a certain license; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally
8 relating to the renewal of certain licenses by the State Board for Professional
9 Land Surveyors.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

2 15-101.

3 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

4 (b) "Board" means the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors.

5 (d) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license
6 issued by the Board to practice:

7 (i) land surveying; or

8 (ii) property line surveying.

9 (2) "License" includes, unless the context requires otherwise:

10 (i) a license to practice land surveying;

11 (ii) a license to practice property line surveying;

12 (iii) a limited license issued under § 15-316 of this title; and

13 (iv) a temporary license issued under § 15-317 of this title.

14 15-314.

15 (a) Unless a license is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section,
16 the license expires on the first June 30 that comes:

17 (1) after the effective date of the license; and

18 (2) in an odd-numbered year.

19 (b) (1) At least 1 month before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the
20 licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:

21 (i) a renewal application form; and

22 (ii) a notice that states:

23 1. the date on which the current license expires;

24 2. the date by which the Board must receive the renewal
25 application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and

26 3. the amount of the renewal fee.

27 (2) The failure of a licensee to receive the notice for which this subsection
28 provides does not prevent the license from expiring as specified under subsection (a)
29 of this section.

1 (c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an
2 additional 2-year term, if the licensee:

3 (1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

4 (2) pays to the Board a renewal fee of:

5 (i) \$60 for a license to practice land surveying; or

6 (ii) \$40 for a license to practice property line surveying; and

7 (3) submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the
8 Board provides.

9 (d) (1) The Board shall renew the license of and issue a renewal certificate
10 to each licensee who meets the requirements of this section.

11 (2) The Board shall include on each renewal certificate that the Board
12 issues:

13 (i) the date on which the current license expires; and

14 (ii) the signatures of the chairman and secretary of the Board,
15 under seal of the Board.

16 (e) The Secretary may determine that licenses issued under this subtitle shall
17 expire on a staggered basis.

18 (F) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE A DEMONSTRATION
19 OF CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY FOR A LICENSEE AS A CONDITION OF
20 RENEWAL OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 1999. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of
23 September 30, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
24 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
