1 (j) If a sign permitting any other turn is in place, vehicular traffic facing a 2 steady red signal, after stopping as required by subsection (h) of this section,

3 cautiously may enter the intersection and make the turn indicated by the sign.

4 (m) Except for those provisions of this section that by their very nature cannot

5 apply, this section applies to a traffic control signal placed at a location other than an

6 intersection. Each stop required by the signal shall be made at a sign or marking on 7 the pavement indicating where the stop shall be made or, if there is no sign or

8 marking, at the signal.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 1999.
