- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (a) On any roadway that is divided into two or more clearly marked lanes for
- 21 vehicular traffic, the following rules, in addition to any others consistent with them,
- 22 apply.
- 23 (b) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single
- 24 lane and may not be moved from that lane or moved from a shoulder or bikeway into
- 25 a lane until [the driver has determined that] it is safe to do so.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1999.
