- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that an insured may recover certain costs and expenses
- 4 under certain circumstances in certain actions to determine insurance coverage

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY 20 PERSON TO MAINTAIN AN ACTION FOR DAMAGES OTHERWISE AVAILABLE.
- 21 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IN ANY CIVIL ACTION
- 22 IN WHICH AN INSURED SUES OR IS SUED BY ITS INSURER TO DETERMINE WHAT
- 23 COVERAGE, IF ANY, EXISTS UNDER THE INSURER'S INSURANCE POLICY OR TO
- 24 DETERMINE THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE INSURED IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE
- 25 PAYMENT FROM THE INSURER FOR A COVERED LOSS, IF THE COURT FINDS IN FAVOR
- 26 OF THE INSURED, THE INSURED MAY RECOVER:

- 1 (1) COSTS AND EXPENSES, INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S FEES, 2 INCURRED BY THE INSURED; AND
- 3 (2) INTEREST AT THE LEGAL RATE ON ALL COSTS AND EXPENSES
- 4 INCURRED BY THE INSURED FROM THE DATE THE CLAIM WAS SUBMITTED TO THE
- 5 INSURER OR ITS AGENT.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 7 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 8 on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 1999.
