1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - Board of Regents - University of Maryland University College**

3 FOR the purpose of exempting a student member of the Board of Regents of the
4 University System of Maryland who is a student in good academic standing at
5 the University of Maryland University College from a certain qualification; and
6 generally relating to the Board of Regents of the University System of
7 Maryland.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

2 12-102.

3 (a) The government of the University System of Maryland is vested in the
4 Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland.

5 (b) The Board of Regents consists of 17 members as follows:

6 (1) (I) [One] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
7 PARAGRAPH, ONE member shall be a full-time student in good academic standing at
8 an institution under the jurisdiction of the Board[;].

9 (II) A STUDENT MEMBER WHO IS IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING AT
10 THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM
11 THE FULL-TIME STUDENT REQUIREMENT IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS
12 PARAGRAPH.

13 (2) One member shall be the State Secretary of Agriculture ex officio;
14 and

15 (3) The remaining members of the Board shall be residents of the State
16 and shall be appointed from the general public.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1999.
