A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Disposition of License Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring in Allegany County the Director of Finance to credit to

4 the county a certain percent of the license fees received for licenses that are

5 issued to a place of business located in a municipal corporation in the county;

6 requiring the Director of Finance to pay a certain percent of the remaining

7 license fees received for these licenses to the respective municipal corporation;

8 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages license fees in Allegany County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 10-204.

23 (b) (1) This subsection applies only in Allegany County.

24 (2) The Director of Finance is the local collecting agent. The Director of

25 Finance shall [remit and pay]:

26 (I) CREDIT 5 PERCENT OF THE LICENSE FEES RECEIVED FOR

27 LICENSES THAT ARE ISSUED TO A PLACE OF BUSINESS LOCATED IN A MUNICIPAL

1 CORPORATION TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY TO COVER ADMINISTRATIVE
2 COSTS; AND

3 (II) PAY 50 PERCENT OF THE REMAINING LICENSE FEES RECEIVED
4 FOR LICENSES THAT ARE ISSUED TO A PLACE OF BUSINESS LOCATED IN A
5 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION [to each incorporated town or city] in the County [50
6 percent of the license fees received for the licenses that are issued for the places of
7 business located within the corporate limits of the respective town or city] TO THE
8 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 1999.
