1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Tidal Fish License - Apprenticeship Permits**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date of certain provisions relating to
4 applicants for apprenticeship permits in connection with tidal fish licenses; and
5 generally relating to tidal fish licenses and apprenticeship permits.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Natural Resources**

20 4-701.1.

21 (g) (4) (i) An applicant for an apprenticeship permit may begin to
22 complete the requirements of paragraphs (1), (2), and (3) of this subsection, if the
23 applicant posts the fee for the apprenticeship permit.

24 (ii) This paragraph does not alter an applicant's position on the
25 waiting list established under subsection (e)(3) of this section.

1 (iii) An applicant shall be issued an apprenticeship permit in
2 accordance with subsection (e)(4) of this section.

3 (iv) An applicant may be credited with the completed requirements
4 that were accrued and documented in accordance with paragraph (2) of this
5 subsection before being issued an apprenticeship permit.

7 SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 4 of this Act
8 shall take effect June 1, 1998. [It shall remain effective until December 31, 2000, and,

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 1999.
