18 PROVIDED BY LAW, the statute of limitations for the prosecution of the crime of
19 conspiracy, ATTEMPT, OR SOLICITATION is the statute of limitations for the
20 prosecution of the substantive crime that is the subject of the conspiracy, ATTEMPT,
21 OR SOLICITATION.
