- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 26 (A) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF:

1 (1) ONE INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND 2 AS EX OFFICIO MEMBERS: (2) 3 (I) THE GOVERNOR: THE STATE SENATOR WHO REPRESENTS THE DISTRICT IN (II)5 WHICH ANNAPOLIS IS LOCATED; 6 (III)THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY: 7 (IV) THE MAYOR OF ANNAPOLIS; AND 8 (V) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE UNITED STATES NAVAL 9 ACADEMY. 10 (B) (1) THE TERM OF THE APPOINTED MEMBER IS 4 YEARS. - 4 IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSION:
- 5 (1) MAY ACCEPT MONEY FROM A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC AGENCY FOR USE 6 IN CARRYING OUT THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION; AND
- 7 (2) FOR THAT PURPOSE, MAY GIVE THE MONEY TO A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC 8 AGENCY OR OTHERWISE SPEND THE MONEY.
