- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EMPLOYER" MEANS THE OWNER OR MANAGER OF A
- 22 BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES PASSENGER-FOR-HIRE SERVICES.
- 23 (B) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 742 THROUGH 755 OF THIS ARTICLE,
- 24 AN EMPLOYER WHO SUBMITS A REQUEST AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF
- 25 THIS SECTION MAY OBTAIN FROM THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY:
- 26 (1) A COPY OF THE RESULTS OF A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND RECORD
- 27 CHECK PERFORMED ON ANY PROSPECTIVE OR CURRENT EMPLOYEE WHO IS

- 1 LICENSED TO PROVIDE PASSENGER-FOR-HIRE SERVICES UNDER TITLE 10 OF THE
- 2 PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES ARTICLE; AND
- 3 (2) INFORMATION RELATING TO THE EXISTENCE OF ANY CONVICTIONS
- 4 OR CRIMINAL CHARGES OCCURRING AFTER THE DATE OF THE INITIAL CRIMINAL
- 5 BACKGROUND RECORD CHECK.
- 6 (C) TO OBTAIN THE INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS
- 7 SECTION, AN EMPLOYER SHALL SUBMIT A WRITTEN REQUEST THAT INCLUDES A
- 8 SIGNED STATEMENT BY THE PROSPECTIVE OR CURRENT EMPLOYEE INDICATING
- 9 THAT THE INDIVIDUAL CONSENTS TO THE RELEASE OF THE REQUESTED
- 10 INFORMATION.
- 11 (D) INFORMATION OBTAINED BY AN EMPLOYER FROM THE CENTRAL
- 12 REPOSITORY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONFIDENTIAL AND MAY BE
- 13 DISSEMINATED ONLY TO THE PROSPECTIVE OR CURRENT EMPLOYEE WHO IS THE
- 14 SUBJECT OF THE CRIMINAL BACKGROUND RECORD CHECK.
- 15 (E) IF AN EMPLOYER REQUESTS INFORMATION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE
- 16 EMPLOYER SHALL PAY TO THE DEPARTMENT ANY REQUIRED PROCESSING FEE AND
- 17 ADMINISTRATIVE COST.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 19 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 20 on a person licensed as a passenger-for-hire driver before the effective date of this
- 21 Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 1999.
