- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

- IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC PLACE" MEANS A PARKING LOT, COMMON 19 (A)
- 20 AREA, OR GENERAL COMMON ELEMENT IN:
- A LEASED RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING ATTACHED 21 (1)
- 22 SINGLE-FAMILY HOMES OR A MULTIFAMILY DWELLING UNIT;
- 23 (2)A CONDOMINIUM; OR
- 24 (3) A HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION.
- 25 (B) THE GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY ADOPT AN
- 26 ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION TO REGULATE THE POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF

- 1 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF
- 2 THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 1999.
