- 21 exchange for remuneration EXCEPT:
- 22 (1) MOTOR VEHICLES DESIGNED TO TRANSPORT MORE THAN 15
- 23 PERSONS; AND
- 24 (2) TRANSPORTATION SOLELY PROVIDED BY OR ON BEHALF OF A UNIT
