- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain State employees are entitled to a certain
- 5 amount of leave with pay in order to take examinations and attend interviews
- for State positions; providing that certain State employees who live or work in
- 7 excess of a certain number of miles away from the site of an examination or
- 8 interview for a State position are entitled to not more than a certain number of
- 9 additional hours of leave with pay; and generally relating to leave with pay for
- 10 State employees taking examinations or attending interviews for State
- 11 positions.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article State Personnel and Pensions

- 21 (A) AN EMPLOYEE IS ENTITLED TO NOT MORE THAN 4 HOURS OF LEAVE WITH
- 22 PAY TO TAKE EXAMINATIONS AND ATTEND INTERVIEWS FOR STATE POSITIONS.
- 23 (B) IN ADDITION TO THE LEAVE WITH PAY PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF
- 24 THIS SECTION, AN EMPLOYEE WHO LIVES OR WORKS MORE THAN 50 MILES FROM
- 25 THE SITE OF AN EXAMINATION OR INTERVIEW FOR A STATE POSITION IS ENTITLED
- 26 TO NOT MORE THAN 4 ADDITIONAL HOURS OF LEAVE WITH PAY FOR THE
- 27 ADDITIONAL TRAVEL TIME NEEDED TO REACH THE TEST OR INTERVIEW SITE.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
