THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL FESTIVAL 26 27 LICENSE FROM HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A 28 DIFFERENT CLASS OR NATURE. 29 (G) THE BOARD: 30 MAY ESTABLISH THE LICENSE FEE; (1)

MAY SELECT ONE WEEKEND, FRIDAY THROUGH SUNDAY INCLUSIVE,

32 ANNUALLY FOR THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL PROVIDED THAT THE WEEKEND THAT IS 33 SELECTED DOES NOT OCCUR ON THE SAME WEEKEND AS THE MARYLAND WINE

## **HOUSE BILL 362**

- 1 (3) SHALL CHOOSE A LOCATION IN THE COUNTY THAT IS NOT LICENSED 2 UNDER THIS ARTICLE FOR THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL; AND
- 3 (4) SHALL ASSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE SPECIAL
- 4 FESTIVAL IS THE PROMOTION OF MARYLAND BEER AND WINE.
- 5 (H) (1) PRODUCTS DISPLAYED AND SOLD SHALL BE:
- 6 (I) INVOICED TO THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE HOLDER BY A 7 LICENSED STATE WHOLESALER, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY: AND
- 8 (II) DELIVERED TO THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL FROM THE LICENSED 9 PREMISES OF THE WHOLESALER, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY.
- 10 (2) WHENEVER A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE IS ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 11 SUBSECTION, HOLDERS OF WHOLESALE, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY LICENSES
- 12 MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL FESTIVAL
- 13 LICENSE TO DELIVER BEER AND WINE 2 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 14 THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE AND TO ACCEPT RETURNS 2 DAYS AFTER THE
- 15 EXPIRATION DATE OF THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE.
- 16 (I) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 June 1, 1999.
