A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Drive-Through Facilities**
3 **MC 911-99**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Montgomery County an alcoholic beverages
5 licensee from operating a drive-through purchase facility where alcoholic
6 beverages are sold at retail, offered for sale, or dispensed through a window or
7 door to a purchaser in or on a motor vehicle for off-premises consumption;
8 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the operation
9 of drive-through facilities in Montgomery County for the sale of alcoholic
10 beverages.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

19 9-216.

20 (D) AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSEE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY MAY
21 NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR DISPENSE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR
22 OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION THROUGH A FACILITY COMMONLY KNOWN AS A
23 DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOW.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act
25 do not apply to an existing alcoholic beverages license that applies to a drive-through
26 purchase facility prior to February 1, 1999, or the transfer of an existing alcoholic
27 beverages license that applies to a drive-through purchase facility.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1999.
