- 20 (D) AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSEE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY MAY
- 21 NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR DISPENSE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR
- 22 OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION THROUGH A FACILITY COMMONLY KNOWN AS A
- 23 DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOW.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act
- 25 do not apply to an existing alcoholic beverages license that applies to a drive-through
- 26 purchase facility prior to February 1, 1999, or the transfer of an existing alcoholic
- 27 beverages license that applies to a drive-through purchase facility.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
