- 17 (A) A constable or police officer is not entitled to any fee for testifying as a
- 18 witness in any case involving a violation of the vehicle laws of this State.
- 19 (B) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE SALARY
- 20 OR OVERTIME PAY PAID BY THE CONSTABLE'S OR POLICE OFFICER'S EMPLOYER.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1999.
