- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Transportation
- 20 21-507.
- 21 (C) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "LANE DIVIDER" MEANS ANY INTERVENING
- 22 SPACE, BARRIER, OR CLEARLY INDICATED DIVIDING SECTION CONSTRUCTED TO
- 23 IMPEDE VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BETWEEN TWO ROADWAYS.
- 24 (2) A PERSON MAY NOT STAND ON A LANE DIVIDER.
- 25 (3) THIS PROHIBITION IN THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

- 1 (I) A PERSON PERFORMING MAINTENANCE OR CONSTRUCTION 2 WORK AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT; (II)A PERSON DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION; 4 OR A PEDESTRIAN PAUSING ON A LANE DIVIDER FOR THE FIRST (III) 6 OPPORTUNITY TO CROSS THE ROADWAY SAFELY. 7 27-101. It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of the 8 (a) 9 Maryland Vehicle Law unless the violation: 10 (1) Is declared to be a felony by the Maryland Vehicle Law or by any 11 other law of this State; or 12 (2) Is punishable by a civil penalty under the applicable provision of the 13 Maryland Vehicle Law.
- 14 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a
- 15 misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is
- 16 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 18 October 1, 1999.
