	(c) (1) On application, the Commissioner may issue a special permit to make agreements for annuity payments with donors to an educational or religious organization not conducted for profit and engaged [solely] in bona fide educational or

- 1 religious activities, to a hospital in the State, or to a community foundation if the 2 educational or religious organization, hospital, or community foundation: except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, has been 4 in active operation in the State for at least 10 years before issuance of the special 5 permit; and has been granted exemption from federal income taxation 6 (ii) 7 under § 501 of the Internal Revenue Code. 8 The Commissioner may issue a special permit to a community (2) 9 foundation that has been in existence for at least 5 years but less than 10 years if the 10 community foundation maintains admitted assets in an amount up to 100% of the 11 contributions made to the community foundation, as determined by the 12 Commissioner.
