17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

HOUSE BILL 495 2 1 **Article - State Government** 2 9-101. 3 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated. 4 (b) "Agency" means the State Lottery Agency. 5 "Licensed agent" means a person or governmental unit licensed by the (g) 6 Director to act as a State lottery sales agent. 7 9-117. During a calendar year, a licensed agent [may not] SHALL receive 8 (a) (1) 9 regular commissions [that exceed] OF 5% of the licensed agent's gross receipts from 10 ticket sales made during that year.

11 (2) A licensed agent may further receive a cashing fee not to exceed 3% of 12 valid prizes paid for services rendered in cashing winning tickets.

13[(3)Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection, the Agency14shall pay a licensed agent a commission of 5% of the licensed agent's gross receipts on15the sale of instant tickets.]
