2 **Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Penalties**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum fine that the Garrett County Board of
4 License Commissioners may impose for a violation of the alcoholic beverages
5 laws; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Garrett County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 16-507.

15 (m) In Garrett County, the Board of License Commissioners may impose a fine
16 of not more than [\$1,000] \$3,000 or suspend a license for any violation of the alcoholic
17 beverages laws affecting Garrett County.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 1999.
