BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 16-507(m) Annotated Code of Maryland (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)	
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:	
3 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

5 (m) In Garrett County, the Board of License Commissioners may impose a fine 6 of not more than [\$1,000] \$3,000 or suspend a license for any violation of the alcoholic 7 beverages laws affecting Garrett County.
