- 2 Worcester County Alcoholic Beverages Class I License
- 3 FOR the purpose of creating in Worcester County a Class I beer, wine and liquor
- 4 license for on-sale privileges only; establishing the terms and conditions for the
- 5 license; limiting where a license may be issued to a certain area; and generally
- 6 relating to alcoholic beverages in Worcester County.
- 7 BY adding to
- 8 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 9 Section 8-224

- 11 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 15 8-224.
- 16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WORCESTER COUNTY.
- 17 (B) THERE IS A CLASS I BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 18 (C) A CLASS I BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED ONLY
- 19 WITHIN:
- 20 (1) THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF OCEAN CITY;
- 21 (2) THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE 10TH ELECTION DISTRICT;
- 22 (3) THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE 2ND PRECINCT OF THE 3RD ELECTION
- 23 DISTRICT; OR

- 1 (4) THE AREA BOUNDED BY MARYLAND ROUTE 589 TO THE NORTH AND 2 EAST, U.S. ROUTE 50 TO THE SOUTH, AND U.S. ROUTE 113 TO THE WEST, ALL OF
- 3 WHICH LIE WITHIN THE 1ST PRECINCT OF THE 3RD ELECTION DISTRICT.
- 4 (D) (1) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR THE 6-DAY LICENSE IS \$3,000.
- 5 (2) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR THE 7-DAY LICENSE IS \$3,500.
- 6 (E) A LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR ON-PREMISES 7 CONSUMPTION ONLY.
- 8 (F) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ALL 9 LICENSE FEES SHALL GO TO THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE COUNTY.
- 10 (2) IF THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, 75 11 PERCENT OF THE FEES SHALL GO TO THAT MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
- 12 (G) (1) A LICENSEE SHALL PURCHASE ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, EXCEPT 13 LIGHT WINE AND BEER, FROM THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.
- 14 (2) A LICENSEE MAY PURCHASE BEER AND LIGHT WINE FROM A 15 LICENSED WHOLESALER.
- 16 (3) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
- 17 LICENSEE SHALL BE CHARGED 85 PERCENT OF THE RETAIL PRICE OR ANY SPECIAL
- 18 SALE PRICE OR DISCOUNT PRICE, WHICHEVER IS LOWER, SET BY THE LIQUOR
- 19 CONTROL BOARD FOR WINE AND LIQUOR.
- 20 (4) THE PRICE THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD CHARGES TO THE
- 21 LICENSEES MAY NOT BE LOWER THAN 10 PERCENT ABOVE THE COST THE LIQUOR
- 22 CONTROL BOARD MUST PAY TO WHOLESALERS FOR THE MERCHANDISE.
- 23 (H) THE HOURS FOR SALE ARE AS PROVIDED IN § 11-524 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 June 1, 1999.
