A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Special Sunday Club Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing in Worcester County the number of special Sunday
4 licenses that the Board of License Commissioners may issue to a club in a
5 calendar year; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Worcester
6 County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

11 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 7-101.

16 (u) (3) (i) There is a special Sunday club license.

17 (ii) The license may be issued to bona fide clubs which already hold
18 a Class C beer, wine and liquor license.

19 (iii) The additional fee is \$10.

20 (iv) A club may be issued no more than [eight] 20 special Sunday
21 licenses during a calendar year.

22 (v) Application for the license shall be made at least 14 days in
23 advance to the Board of License Commissioners. The license is subject to the approval
24 of application by the Board and subject also to other conditions, regulations and
25 restrictions as established by the Board for the consumption of those alcoholic
26 beverages on the premises.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1999.
