- 15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WORCESTER COUNTY.
- 16 (B) THERE IS A CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE)
- 17 LICENSE.
- 18 (C) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR THE USE OF A GOLF COURSE OR
- 19 ORGANIZATION THAT:
- 20 (1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC;
- 21 (2) IS OPERATED FOR PROFIT;
- 22 (3) OWNS REAL ESTATE IN THE COUNTY; AND
- 23 (4) HAS A GOLF COURSE WITH A MINIMUM OF 18 HOLES.
- 24 (D) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$2,625.

- 1 (E) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS,
- 2 THE LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ONLY ON 3 THE LAND AND IN THE BUILDINGS THAT ARE PART OF THE GOLF COURSE.
- 4 (F) A PATRON NEED NOT BE SEATED TO BE SERVED.
- 5 THE HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE ARE AS SPECIFIED IN § 11-524 OF THIS (G)
- 6 ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 June 1, 1999.
