SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
14 8-507.
15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WORCESTER COUNTY.
16 (B) THERE IS A CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE) 17 LICENSE.
18 (C) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR THE USE OF A GOLF COURSE OR 19 ORGANIZATION THAT:
20 (1) IS OPEN TO THE DIRECT

- 1 (2) IS OPERATED FOR PROFIT;
- 2 (3) OWNS REAL ESTATE IN THE COUNTY; AND
- 3 (4) HAS A GOLF COURSE WITH A MINIMUM OF 18 HOLES.
- 4 (D) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$2,625.
- 5 (E) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS,
- 6 THE LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ONLY ON
- 7 THE LAND AND IN THE BUILDINGS THAT ARE PART OF THE GOLF COURSE.
- 8 (F) A PATRON NEED NOT BE SEATED TO BE SERVED.
- 9~ (G) The Hours and days of sale are as specified in \S 11-524 of this 10 article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 June 1, 1999.
