1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Golf Course Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of creating in Worcester County a certain golf course alcoholic  
4 beverages license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Worcester  
5 County.

6 BY adding to  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 8-507  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 8-507.

15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WORCESTER COUNTY.

16 (B) THERE IS A CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE)  
17 LICENSE.

18 (C) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR THE USE OF A GOLF COURSE OR  
19 ORGANIZATION THAT:

20 (1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC;

- 1           (2)     IS OPERATED FOR PROFIT;
- 2           (3)     OWNS REAL ESTATE IN THE COUNTY; AND
- 3           (4)     HAS A GOLF COURSE WITH A MINIMUM OF 18 HOLES.
- 4     (D)     THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$2,625.
- 5     (E)     SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS,  
6 THE LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ONLY ON  
7 THE LAND AND IN THE BUILDINGS THAT ARE PART OF THE GOLF COURSE.
- 8     (F)     A PATRON NEED NOT BE SEATED TO BE SERVED.
- 9     (G)     THE HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE ARE AS SPECIFIED IN § 11-524 OF THIS  
10 ARTICLE.
- 11     SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
12 June 1, 1999.
