## 1 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 2 7-207. 3 (c) (1) In this subsection, "eligible veteran" means a veteran of any branch 4 of the armed forces of the United States who has received an honorable discharge or 5 a certificate of satisfactory completion of military service. 6 7-209. Except as otherwise provided by law, AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF 7 8 THIS SECTION, an appointing authority shall make an appointment from among the 9 candidates in a rating category on a list of eligible candidates as follows: 10 (1) if there are at least five candidates rated best qualified, from that 11 rating category; 12 if there are fewer than five candidates rated best qualified, from the 13 candidates in the best qualified and better qualified categories; and 14 if there are fewer than five candidates rated best qualified and better (3)15 qualified, from candidates in best qualified, better qualified, and qualified categories. A CANDIDATE WHO IS AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN UNDER § 7 207(C) OF THIS 16 17 SUBTITLE SHALL BE SELECTED FOR APPOINTMENT BEFORE A CANDIDATE WHO IS 18 NOT AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN AND WHO IS IN THE SAME RATING CATEGORY AS THE 19 ELIGIBLE VETERAN OR A LOWER RATING CATEGORY. A CANDIDATE WHO IS AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN UNDER § 7-207(C) OF THIS 20 SUBTITLE SHALL BE IDENTIFIED AS AN ELIGIBLE VETERAN ON THE LIST OF 22 ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES. 23 In making a selection, the appointing authority may interview (C) (1) 24 any of the candidates in the rating category from which the selection will be made. 25 When interviews are conducted under this section, the appointing (2) 26 authority must interview at least three candidates.

The appointing authority must certify to the Secretary that the

28 hiring process was conducted in accordance with the selection plan and this subtitle.
