12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(a) (1) In this section "pet" means a domesticated animal.
17	(2) "Pet" does not include livestock.
18 19	(b) The measure of damages for tortious injuries to OR DEATH OF a pet is THE GREATER OF:
20	(1) the market value of the pet before the injury OR DEATH [or]; OR
21 22	(2) the [reasonable] ACTUAL cost of veterinary care [, but not more than \$2,500 if such charge is greater].
23 24	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
