- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of Transportation from spending any
- 5 funds or granting approvals or permits for certain purposes relating to certain
- 6 proposed highway projects in Prince George's County and Montgomery County;
- 7 clarifying language; and generally relating to highways in Prince George's

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Transportation

17 8-601.

- 18 (a) The Administration shall construct, reconstruct, and repair State
- 19 highways as necessary and shall maintain them in good condition.
- 20 (b) The Department may not spend any further funds for the construction of
- 21 I-95 through Prince George's County that will involve a new or reconstructed
- 22 segment connecting it to any other highway in Prince George's County. The
- 23 Department may not spend any further funds for the construction of a new highway,
- 24 arterial, freeway, or expressway in the right-of-way described in the 1980 highway
- 25 needs inventory as the right-of-way reserved for the project designated as the
- 26 Rockville Facility in Montgomery County.
- 27 (c) [This prohibition] SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION does not preclude
- 28 the construction of improvements at grade intersections and railroad crossings in the

- 1 right-of-way designated as the Rockville Facility to facilitate traffic flow and
- 2 highway safety.
- 3 (D) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY AND MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE
- 4 DEPARTMENT MAY NOT SPEND ANY FUNDS OR GRANT ANY APPROVALS OR PERMITS
- 5 FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION FOR, OR THE DESIGN OR CONSTRUCTION OF:
- 6 (1) THE PROPOSED INTERCOUNTY CONNECTOR DESIGNATED BY THE
- 7 MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION AS HIGHWAY
- 8 A-44 EAST OF U.S. ROUTE 1 (BALTIMORE-WASHINGTON BOULEVARD):
- 9 (2) THE PROPOSED HIGHWAY DESIGNATED BY THE
- 10 MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION AS HIGHWAY
- 11 A-58; OR
- 12 (3) THE PROPOSED WASHINGTON BYPASS (EASTERN ROUTE AND
- 13 WESTERN ROUTE).
- 14 (E) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT SPEND ANY FUNDS, GRANT ANY APPROVALS,
- 15 OR SELL OR OTHERWISE TRANSFER ANY LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A
- 16 HIGHWAY IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY CONNECTING THE I-270 CORRIDOR NEAR THE
- 17 ROCKVILLE/GAITHERSBURG AREA OR THE MIDCOUNTY HIGHWAY AREA IN
- 18 MONTGOMERY COUNTY AND THE I-95 CORRIDOR NEAR THE LAUREL AREA IN PRINCE
- 19 GEORGE'S COUNTY, A PROJECT COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE INTERCOUNTY
- 20 CONNECTOR.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 22 effect October 1, 1999.
