- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article Tax General
- 13 11-205.
- 14 The sales and use tax does not apply to a sale of:
- 15 (1) a Maryland State flag; [or]
- 16 (2) a United States flag; OR
- 17 (3) A PRISONER OF WAR FLAG HONORING AND REMEMBERING
- 18 MILITARY PERSONNEL WHO HAVE SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED
- 19 STATES.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 21 effect July 1, 1999.
