2 Homicide - Use of Deadly Force in Residence - Defense

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that a person who uses deadly force or force likely to
- 4 cause death within the person's residence is presumed to have held a reasonable
- fear of imminent peril of death or serious physical injury to the person or a
- 6 member of the person's family or household, if the force is used against another
- who unlawfully and forcibly enters or has entered the person's residence;
- 8 providing that a person is not civilly liable for any act or omission in protecting
- 9 or attempting to protect the person or a member of the person's family or
- 10 household; and generally relating to the use of deadly force in a residence.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) A PERSON WHO USES DEADLY FORCE OR FORCE LIKELY TO CAUSE DEATH
- 21 WITHIN THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE IS PRESUMED TO HAVE HELD A REASONABLE
- 22 FEAR OF IMMINENT PERIL OF DEATH OR SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO THE PERSON
- 23 OR A MEMBER OF THE PERSON'S FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD, IF THE FORCE IS USED
- 24 AGAINST ANOTHER WHO UNLAWFULLY AND FORCIBLY ENTERS OR HAS ENTERED
- 25 THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE.
- 26 (B) A PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS NOT
- 27 CIVILLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION IN PROTECTING OR ATTEMPTING TO
- 28 PROTECT THE PERSON OR A MEMBER OF THE PERSON'S FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
