3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a local health department to access electronically

4 from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene a certified or abridged copy

- 5 of a death certificate under certain circumstances; authorizing a local health

- 7 circumstances; authorizing the Department under certain circumstances to
- 8 establish certain remote sites for the purpose of issuing birth certificates, to
- 9 access electronically at the remote site a certified or abridged copy of a certain
- 10 birth certificate and, on request, to provide at the remote site a certain person
- 11 with a certified or abridged copy of a certain birth certificate; providing for the
- 12 disposition of a certain fee collected by the Department; authorizing the

13 Department to set and collect a certain fee for processing and issuing a birth

- 14 certificate from a remote site or for a certain report; prohibiting a certain fee
- 15 from exceeding certain actual costs of the Department; and generally relating to
- 16 certain vital records.

1 THE FEE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR PROCESSING AND (II)2 ISSUING A BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR FOR A REPORT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS 3 PARAGRAPH MAY NOT EXCEED THE ACTUAL COSTS TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR 4 PROCESSING AND ISSUING A BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR A REPORT. 5 FROM THE FEE THE DEPARTMENT COLLECTS UNDER (III) 6 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, \$4 SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE 7 GENERAL FUND. 8 (3)(i) Any local health department may set and collect a fee for 9 processing and issuing a birth certificate, or for a report that a search of the files was 10 made and the requested record is not on file, that covers: 11 1. The Secretary may waive all or part of a fee if chargeable to an 26 (5)27 agency of the United States. 28 (6)The Department may not collect a fee for a copy of a vital record 29 issued to: 30 A current or former member of the armed forces of the United (i) 31 States; or The surviving spouse or child of the member, if the copy will be 32 (ii) 33 used in connection with a claim for a dependent or beneficiary of the member. 34 (d) Any local health department may set and collect a fee for processing (1)35 and issuing a death certificate that covers the administrative costs of providing this

36 service.

1 (2) The fee set by the local health department for processing and issuing 2 a death certificate under this subsection may not exceed the actual costs to the local 3 health department for processing and issuing a death certificate.

4 (e) The Secretary shall include with every copy of a death certificate, in a form 5 prescribed and provided by the Insurance Commissioner, a notice which advises that 6 certain individuals may be entitled to continuation of group health insurance benefits 7 under § 15-407 of the Insurance Article.

8 (f) The Secretary shall include with every copy of a death certificate, in a form 9 prescribed by the Insurance Commissioner, a notice which advises that certain 10 individuals may be entitled to become members of the Maryland Group Health 11 Insurance Plan under Title 14, Subtitle 3 of the Insurance Article.

12 (g) A person may use a photocopy of a birth, death, fetal death, or marriage 13 certificate for any nonfraudulent and nondeceptive purpose.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 1999.
