A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights - Applicability**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the definition of "law enforcement officer" as it applies
4 to the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights to include certain additional
5 police officers; and generally relating to the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of
6 Rights.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments**

15 727.

16 (b) "Law enforcement officer" means any person who, in an official capacity, is
17 authorized by law to make arrests and who is a member of one of the following law
18 enforcement agencies:

- 19 (1) The Department of State Police;
- 20 (2) The Baltimore City Police Department;
- 21 (3) The Baltimore City School Police Force;
- 22 (4) The police department, bureau, or force of any county;
- 23 (5) The police department, bureau, or force of any incorporated city or
24 town;

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- 1 (6) The office of the sheriff of any county or Baltimore City;
- 2 (7) The police department, bureau, or force of any bicounty agency[, or
3 the University of Maryland];
- 4 (8) The police forces of the Department of Transportation;
- 5 (9) The police officers of the Department of Natural Resources;
- 6 (10) The Investigative Services Unit of the Comptroller's Office;
- 7 (11) Housing Authority of Baltimore City Police Force;
- 8 (12) The Crofton Police Department;
- 9 (13) The police officers of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- 10 (14) The police officers of the Department of General Services;
- 11 (15) The police officers of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and
12 Regulation; [or]
- 13 (16) The State Fire Marshal or a full-time investigative and inspection
14 assistant of the Office of the State Fire Marshal; OR
- 15 (17) THE POLICE OFFICERS OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND,
16 MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, OR ST. MARY'S COLLEGE.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1999.
