8 9	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 14	(1) "Subdivision" means any county of Maryland but does not include Baltimore City; or where the context requires, the governing body thereof.
	(2) "Municipality" means any incorporated city or town, except Baltimore City, within Maryland; or where the context requires, the governing body thereof.
20	(b) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975, and thereafter, the State shall pay to each subdivision, and to each qualifying municipality, each year in the manner and subject to the limitations and requirements hereinafter provided, an amount determined as follows:
22 23	(5) Supplemental Grant. (i) In addition to the payments made under subparagraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of this subsection, the State shall pay:
24 25	1. To each subdivision, subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, an amount the equivalent of $\{\$2.50\}$ $\$3.50$ per capita; and
26 27	2. To Baltimore City, an amount the equivalent of [fifty cents] \$1.50 per capita.
	(ii) The State shall allocate and distribute the supplemental grant to each subdivision among the subdivisions and the qualifying municipalities in those subdivisions on a per capita basis.
33 34	(8) Municipal Sworn Officer Allocation. The State shall pay to each qualifying municipality, in addition to the payments made under subparagraphs (1) through (7) of this subsection an amount equal to [\$1,200] \$1,800 for each sworn police officer actually employed on a full-time basis by the qualifying municipality, as determined by the Secretary.

- 6 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 be provided from revenues generated through
- 7 the enactment of Section 2 of Chapter _____ (H.B. 190) of the Acts of the General
- 8 Assembly of 1999, including the revenues attributable to the "floor tax" requirement
- 9 under Section 5 of that Act.

- 11 IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the additional \$600 in payments provided under
- 12 Article 88B, § 66(b)(8) of the Code as enacted by Section 1 of this Act may not be used
- 13 by a qualifying municipality to supplant existing local funding for police protection.
